



Nazarene Preschool 2020-2021 School Year - August 1 Update

We are planning on a great year at Nazarene Preschool! Our goal at Nazarene Preschool is to ensure our environment is as safe as possible while maintaining the integrity of our preschool program. We will be limiting interaction and social distancing where possible. As we follow the CDC/DCFS guidelines, we recognize that the situation is fluid and guidelines may need to change as the situation changes.

Our basic plan includes:

Student and Staff Health and Wellness

Parents will be expected to pre-screen students at home daily prior to arriving at school. This will include a COVID symptom checklist for each child attending school. Parents/guardians are required to keep your child home when your child is ill.

Social Distancing

Social distancing (6 feet) will be observed as much as possible.

- *Classrooms will also be set-up to promote social distancing between students.
- *There will be a certain traffic pattern for children moving from their classroom to the restrooms, music class, and gym time.
- *Students will not be sharing their school supplies.
- *Adjustments will be made for arrival and pickup times and procedures
- *Visitors in the building will be limited
- *Large gatherings (orientation, program, etc.) will be adjusted appropriately

Face Covering

- *Nazarene staff will wear masks at all times
- *Students in the 3's and 4's program will need to wear a mask as they enter and exit the building. Students will also need to wear a mask when they are walking in the hallways. While children are in their rooms, it will be optional for the child to wear a mask.
- *Students in the Young 3's program will not be required to wear a mask.
- *All adults entering the Nazarene building are required to wear a mask.
